

Japan 's support to IAI Attachment Programme







1. Background

- ◆ The Attachment Program aims to <u>reduce disparities</u> <u>within the ASEAN region</u>.
- ◆ It has been supported since its inception in 2001 by Japan (initially through the Japan-ASEAN Integration and Exchange Fund (JAGEF) and later through Japan-ASEAN Integration Fund (JAIF)).



2. Outline

- Young government officials (diplomats and officials from economic and social/cultural ministries) from Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar and Viet Nam (CLMV) are dispatched to the ASEAN Secretariat for one year, with a view to enhancing administrative capacities of the participants.
- ◆ <u>From 2025</u>, government officials <u>from Timor-Leste also participate</u> in the programme.

3. Budget/Number of Participants

- ◆ Approximately USD 800,000-1,000,000 per batch.
- ◆ A total of <u>120 quality graduates</u> have been produced to date.
