1. Support towards ASEAN's Effort on COVID-19 Response to Myanmar through the Provision of Medical Supplies and Equipment for Phase 1 (Life-Saving)

- ◆ Budget: 2,526,202.18 USD
- ◆ Duration: October 2022 - March 2024 (Implemented)
- ◆ Achievement: The project significantly contributed to the ASEAN's Effort on COVID-19 response to Myanmar through the provision of medical supplies and equipment. These medical supplies and equipment were distributed to the public hospitals and health departments in all 17 states and regions across Myanmar.



2. Provision of Humanitarian Assistance to Vulnerable People in Myanmar (Phase 2: Life-sustaining)

- ◆ Budget: 2,660,420.00 USD
- ◆ Duration: Jan 2024 - July 2025 (On-going)
- ◆ Achievement: Procured food packages, family kits and personal hygiene kits were successfully distributed to internally displaced persons (IDPs) in Myanmar (Items will be distributed to more than 18,000 households (100,000 people) in total by the end of March 2025)



3. Provision of Humanitarian Assistance to Vulnerable People and IDPs in Myanmar (Phase 2-2: Life-sustaining)

- ◆ Budget: 2,783,029.70 USD
- ◆ Duration: July 2025 - July 2026 (Approved)
- ◆ Proposed Achievement:
 - ✓ Procurement of four (4) types of humanitarian assistance: food commodities, WASH items, family kits, and personal hygiene kits estimated by end of December 2025
 - ✓ Distribution of procured items to an estimated a total of 33,000 households/21,150 people

4. New Contribution for Humanitarian Assistance to Myanmar through the AHA Centre

- ◆ Budget: 2,783,712 USD
- ◆ Date of Disbursement to Japan-ASEAN Integration Fund (JAIF) : 17 March 2025
