Strategic Measures

4.1.1. Accelerate the implementation of One Health Initiative by enhancing institutional and human capacity, increasing investment, research and development for public health prevention, preparedness and response (PPR) activities, and <u>strengthening the capacity and</u> <u>resources of ASEAN-related centres such as ACPHEED</u>.

Japan's Support

Japan-ASEAN Integration Fund (JAIF) to be proposed to CPR/JAPAN

- **50 million USD to** the JAIF for the support of ACPHEED in 2020.
- [Thailand] Preparation of <u>Response Centre</u> of the ASEAN Centre for Public Health Emergencies and Emerging Diseases in Thailand
- [Indonesia] Preparation Support for the Infrastructures of the ASEAN Centre for Public Health Emergencies and Emerging Diseases (ACPHEED) for <u>Detection and Risk Assessment</u>

JICA Ongoing

Five (5) experts, including experts from Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW) of Japan and Japan Institute of Health Security (JIHS), have been dispatched to Thailand since January 2025.
